React is a Javascript library, created by Facebook for building web applications.

React provides a way to structure and manage complex web apps.

The building blocks of React are components. A React component combines Javascript logic, with HTML-like JSX markup.

The course shows how Javascript ES6 and React fit together. The command-line tools used to build React apps are introduced.
