What is SASS?

SASS extends the CSS stylesheet language with features commonly found in programming languages. SASS adds variables, functions, loops and conditional statements to CSS.

SASS enables you to create better structured, more self-documenting code for large web projects.

SASS is a relevant software tool for web designers and developers building sites in HTML and CSS.

Prerequisites

A knowledge of HTML and CSS fundamentals.

No knowledge of a programming language is assumed.
